**Friday 1<sup>st</sup> May** Practice 0800hrs – 1600hrs

**Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> May Rifle Matches** Rifle Scrutineering 0700hrs, briefing 0730hrs, Competition begins 0800hrs.

Event 1 – Match 12 Rapid Fire 50m Standard (Open) and Accurised OR IOC (open) Target C  
Event 2 – Match 1 3P Core Event (Shot 100m, 200m, 300m) Standard (Graded/Junior) and Accurised OR IOC (Open)  
Event 3 – Match 10 Deliberate 300m Standard (Graded & Junior) & Accurised OR IOC (Open)  
Event 4 – Match 24 – Local Event - 50m Combo - 10 rounds Rifle (Carbine, Lever Action, or Breech Loading etc. In this event you are NOT allowed to use your Standard Rifle. You must use a Centre Fire Rifle from the approved List.) and 12 rounds Class 1 Pistol - (Graded and Junior) PISTOL GRADE DENOTES YOUR GRADE for this event.  
Medals for Rifle events 1, 2 & 3, Teams event, Top Gun and Top Gun Junior.

Top Gun and Teams event based on combined scores Standard Rifle Events 1, 2 & 3.

**Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> May Pistol Matches** Pistol Scrutineering 0700hrs, Briefing 0730hrs, Competition begins 0800hrs.

*Class 1, 2, 3 and 4 pistols. Class 1 to be shot first. Competitors may shoot all eligible classes.*

Event 5 – Match 9 50m Long Range Class 1, 2 and 3 Open and Junior  
Event 6 – Match 7 Standing Rapid Fire 25m Class 1 Open and Junior  
Event 7 – Match 1 Pistol 3P Core (shot 25m, 15m, 7m) Class 1 & 2 Graded and Junior, Class 3 Open and Junior  
Event 8 – Chairman's Challenge- Match 1 Practice 3 Standing unsupported strong hand and Practice 4 kneeling unsupported freestyle and Match 4 standing deliberate. Total 24 rounds. (Pre 1946 original handgun) Open & Junior

**.22 Trainer and .310 Cadet shot after the completion of the Pistol Competition.**

Event 9 – Match 25 3P Core Event .22 Training Rifle (shot 50m, 75m, 100m) Graded and Junior  
Event 10 - Match 25 3P Core Event .310 Cadet Training Rifle (shot 50m, 75m, 100m) Graded and Junior

Please Note: Pistols not on the Class 1 or 2 Approved Lists need to be Approved. Please check the List on the National CSD Website. Class 3 Pistols are a Modified Class 1 or 2 as per Rule 6.2.1 Class.

Junior Competitors can use a Class 4 Pistol in their category at the Chairman's discretion.

(Resolution from 2022 National CSD Sub-Committee Meeting) However for a Junior to be eligible for Graded Medals, a Class 1, 2 or 3 handgun must be used.
